Portrait time after the ceremony is generally very precious as there is a lot to be done between the ceremony and the couple's entrance to the reception. I caution clients to keep in mind that it takes on average two minutes per pose for family portraiture, five minutes per extended family pose, so make sure you actually need to poses you order. If you are choosing to do your couple portraiture after the ceremony as well, we will need 25-40 minutes on average to complete couple portraiture depending on how many locations you want and travel needs. Take all of that into consideration when completing this checklist. Thanks!
